Now, you are probably wondering what all this talk about ducks and dogs has to do with you. Well, you know, there are some children who think that if they hang around Christians, go to Sunday School, Vacation Bible School and Bible Camps, that they are alright with God.

But do you know what? Hanging around Christians and doing what they do cannot make you a Christian anymore than hanging around dogs made that duck a dog!

That duck still had its duck nature, and you still have only your sinful nature if you have never asked the Lord Jesus to be your Saviour. In your sinful nature, there is only one thing you can produce $-\sin - just$ as that duck produced eggs.

"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23).

The only way you can be a Christian and do things pleasing to God, is by getting a new nature -a Christ-like nature. "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things are passed away; behold all things are become new" (2 Corinthians 5:17).

Bring to the Lord Jesus your old life with all your bad thoughts, words and actions. Believe that He died on the cross for you. Know that He is risen from the dead and is in heaven calling to you: "Come unto me...and I will give you rest" (Matthew 11:28). He can and He will take your sins away and give you a new nature. Come to Him now, and get that new nature.
